### Role Responsibility

- Assist in all major events taking place in the summer for campus teams
- Work through the apprentice model in small group format
- Attend all meetings including ministry, campus, and staff meetings
- Develop people who serve on the campus for spiritual and personal growth
- Keep an "Intern's Journal". This journal will be a snapshot of the ongoing development the intern experiences during the program.
- Observe each campus adult program to see how they function in relation to our church's mission

## Internship Project

The intern will develop an internship project in agreement with his or her supervisor. This project will cover a scope for the entire internship program and will focus on specific skills and results that will further develop the intern.

#### Evaluation

- Weekly meetings with the Intern Supervisor for the purpose of personal development and project management.
- Weekly evaluation with the Intern Director for leadership development and discipleship
