Kids Ministry Intern

Position Summary

The Kids summer ministry intern position can generally expect to assist with weekend preparation tasks, participate in the curriculum development process, and have the opportunity to be a coach or small group leader in the kids area. A large percentage of the intern's development will take place through hands-on ministry experience.

Personal Development Plan

The intern will create a development plan over the scope of their internship. This would include a character, value, and ministry goal he or she wants to grow in while performing as an intern. The intern will present to their mentor and supervisor key takeaways from their plan at the end of the internship.

Evaluation

The intern will meet daily with his or her mentor for the purpose of discipleship/development. Final evaluation will take place with the intern supervisor and internship director.
