Role Responsibility

- Learn and assist the staff in service planning and execution of leading worship on the weekend.
- Works with music and production staff in volunteer development and training
- Assist music and production staff in all aspects of song selection, powerpoint production and exporting to pro-presenter.
- Attend all meetings up to and including: ministry specific, service evaluation and staff meetings
- Attends all rehearsals and comes prepared to lead a campus for the weekend
- The intern will be responsible to keep an "Intern's Journal". This journal will be a snapshot of the ongoing development the intern experiences during the program.
- The intern can expect to perform on each of our campuses on the weekend

Internship Project

The intern will develop an internship project in agreement with his or her supervisor. This project will cover a scope for the entire internship program and will focus on specific skills and results that will further develop the intern.

Evaluation
