WARM UP

Are you always late or always early?

SET IT UP

Temptation works like a trap. Step by step we are drawn toward our own demise. Samson's old weakness for women drew him deeper and deeper into trouble until the trap was sprung. The pleasure evaporated and the consequences landed. He lost his eyes, his honor, and his incredible power. But God wasn't done with him yet.

CHAT IT UP

1. **What was your least favorite discipline you earned growing up?**
2. **Read Judges 16:18-21. Samson chose his actions but he didn't choose the consequences. What were the consequences of Samson's actions?**
3. **Dan said, "Don't wander in a war zone." Where had Samson wandered?**
4. **A war zone is a place where you know you'll be tempted. Where do people "wander" today? (Ex: Internet, "bad crowd," bars, casinos, etc.)**
5. **Have you ever made the same mistake over and over but finally changed? What made the difference?**
6. **Read Judges 16:27-30. Dan said, "God keeps His promises even when we don't." How do you see that truth in this passage?**
7. **This whole series has challenged us to rise up and fight instead of disengaging and drifting. Where do you need to step it up? How can our group help you?**

WRAP IT UP

No matter how far you've fallen you are not beyond the reach of grace. Your mistakes cannot stop God's grace. It's never too late to rise up. When you don't think God can use you—He is fighting for you. Rise up, there are still things worth fighting for.
