

## Music & Production Summer Intern Position

### Position Summary

The Summer Ministry intern position will be a chance for an individual to learn about music and production. Through this internship the individual will assist the Music and Production Department and will be encouraged to grow in their personal, spiritual and ministry goals. A large percentage of the intern's development will take place through hand-on ministry experience.

- Enjoys leading people in worship and has good stage presence
- Supports the mission, vision, and values of Parker Hill Church
- Displays openness to learning new skills
- Flexible schedule so he or she is able to commit to the 25-hour volunteer schedule

### Role Responsibility

- Assist the staff in planning and execution of weekend services and special events within the context of one or more of the following tracks:
  1. **Music Track:** crafting worship set lists, preparing music, leading band rehearsals, building and mixing tracks/stems, and leading worship
  2. **Audio Track:** mixing a live band, running a sound check, working with an input list and stage plot, gear maintenance, and building and mixing tracks/stems
  3. **Video Track:** producing creative video content, working on various aspects of technical stagecraft, and maintaining/installing live media presentation systems
- Work with Music & Production staff to equip, train, and develop volunteers
- Explore, train, and operate various area-specific technologies
- Serve and/or lead at each of our three locations
- Maintain an "Intern's Journal"—a snapshot of the ongoing development experienced during the program

### Internship Project

The intern will develop an internship project in agreement with his or her supervisor. This project will cover a scope for the entire internship program and will focus on specific skills and results that will further develop the intern.

### Evaluation

- Weekly meetings with the intern supervisor for the purpose of personal development and project management.
- Weekly evaluation with the Intern Director for personal development and discipleship.
- Final evaluation for the intern will take place with the intern supervisor and internship director. The purpose of the final evaluation is to provide the intern with next steps to take and ministry experience for personal and leadership development.
