## Must I Choose Between Science & Faith?

### GET GOING

Is faith blind? Does following God mean we should turn off our brains? Must we choose between science and faith? Many have wrestled with similar questions. Some have concluded that science and faith cannot coexist. While others have found that science is not the enemy of God, it is the evidence of God.

### DISCUSS

1. **What natural wonder has taken your breath away?**
2. **Should faith in God be blind or require evidence? Explain.**
3. **Read Psalm 19:1-6. What is the writer of this Psalm saying about the natural world?** (Answer: Creation constantly proclaims the existence of God.)
4. **What is one thing you used to believe but have since changed your mind about?** (It can be big or small.)
5. **Does a person have to believe in the six day creation account to become a follower of Jesus? Why or why not?**
6. **What made you decide to become a follower of Jesus?**
7. Every 1 matters. And every conversation we have has the potential to help people find the way back to God. **What should be our goal when discussing or debating topics like creation with people far from God? How does that change how we talk?**

### WRAP IT UP

The deeper you dive into the questions of life, the more convincing God's answers often become. As C.S. Lewis put it, "I believe in Christianity as I believe that the sun has risen: not only because I see it, but because by it I see everything else."
