GET GOING

- With chairs formed in a circle, make sure everyone has a chair. You will then take away one chair and you can decide who will be the person to start the game.

- The person sitting will say Yes, especially those who (fill in the adjective here). For example, "Yes especially those who have eyebrows!"
- Then all must leave their seats and find a new seat to sit in.
- The last person standing and without a seat is it and has to ask someone new if they love their neighbor!
- Play for a few turns, it get's pretty crazy.

Discuss

1. When was there a time when someone went out of their way to serve you? How did it make you feel.
2. Mark mentioned that when the local church is working right, there is nothing like it in the world! How has someone blessed you by their role of serving at Parker Hill?

3. As Mark described the context of this passage, he mentioned that no one was looking to serve one another that night at the passover meal. Why do you think people are so naturally inclined to want to be served?
4. If it were you're last night on earth, what would you do? How does what Jesus do raise the bar for everyone of His followers?

5. As Jesus wraps up his lesson to the disciples, He says “God will bless you for serving”. If you’re currently serving in at Parker Hill talk a little about your role. How have you seen God use you in the lives of others?
6. If you’re not currently serving, what’s stopping you? How can serving
