GET GOING

DISCUSS

1. **What, if any, is your favorite sport to watch? If you could be incredible at one sport what would it be?**
2. **Have you ever been part of a team? What team? What is one your favorite team experiences?**
3. **Read Matthew 25:14-27.** Summarize the story together by answering these questions: **What happened? What was the master's responses to the three servants? What is the point of the parable?** (Possible Answer: God expects us to do something to advance His agenda with everything He has given us.)
4. **What was the difference between the first two servants who both doubled what the master had given them?** (Answer: The only difference was the amount they started with.) **What does that teach us about what God has given us? What was their reward?** (Answer: It doesn't matter how much we have, it matters what we do with it.)
5. **Finances are the obvious area to think about; but what other ways does God gift us for helping people find the way back to God?** (Some Answers: spiritual gifts, hobbies, skills, relationships/connections, education, experiences, etc.)
6. Pastor Mark said, "We are going to need everyone to reach every 1." That happens when we take what God has poured into us and we pour it into others. **Can you share a story of when someone else poured into your life?**
7. **What's the takeaway for you? What you think God is calling you to do?** (Is it to start serving? To take on more responsibility? Spend some time pouring into someone specific?)

You don't have to pour into everyone, you just need to pour into someone. Someone needs you! Pouring into others changes you for the better! Make it a point this week to pour yourself out for someone else.
