## Part 4: Can I Lose My Salvation?

### GET GOING

We live in a world where there is constant pressure to achieve and measure up. It's no wonder we bring the same mentality into our relationship with Jesus. But what if our logic is faulty? What is our relationship with God has little to do with how we measure up?

### DISCUSS

1. Share a little bit about your faith background. Did you grow up in a different religious tradition? What were some of the things you remember from that tradition?
2. Why do you think “I hope so” is the answer of so many people when asked if they are going to heaven?
3. If there is a good God, then he would definitely tell us how good we have to be to enter heaven, he would define that for us specifically and clearly. Do you agree or disagree and why?
4. Read Romans 8:1. What does Paul tell us is the basis for being accepted by God? Have you ever known someone that thought keeping the 10 commandments was the way to heaven? Have you ever thought that? Why can that never work?
5. Read Romans 8:15-16. How does this picture of being adopted into God's family help answer the question, “can I lose my salvation”? How would you describe the difference between unconditional and conditional love?
6. Read Romans 8:31-39. According to Paul if we are in Christ nothing can separate us from God and our restored relationship with Him. How can being sure of our salvation change the way we live right now?
7. After hearing this week's message, what are you trusting in to secure your relationship with God?
